

The 'Change of Use' planning application has been submitted and is being processed.

We have added to the planning application a proposal for an open pergola structure – this will enable the collection of rainwater and also provide shelter when needed.

As soon as we have agreed the positions and type of gates (e.g. wood/metal), we will be seeking 3 quotes for their installation. Note that the rough estimate provided at short notice by the designer for the October meeting was just that, and should not be taken as a firm quote.

The archeological magnetometry survey showed nothing of interest, but the resistivity team thinks it may be worth further investigating an area just behind the trees on the St John's Street border near Elms Close. If anyone has experience and wishes to lead or be involved in digging a test pit, please contact the Clerk.
