

- After a few more glitches, our contractor has submitted the request for a slot for works on the highway, needed before he can construct the entrances. Unfortunately Cambs Streetworks have advised that there may be a delay in granting permission, due to a backlog of work, but we are nevertheless hopeful that entrances will be complete by mid May.
- The margin of 10% agreed by DPC last month was not needed and payment has been made as agreed in March, to Highways for the fee and the refundable deposit.
- The grass will be cut according to the design over the summer. Many thanks to Ashley Arbon for offering to do this at no cost to DPC over the summer period.
- When landscaping is complete, a DPC maintenance contract will be put out to tender.
