

- The saga of the Elms Close pavement entrance: the contractor will return to re-lay the tarmac and reduce the gradient on the pavement. Thankfully Highways have agreed that the gravel boards can remain in place as they are situated on Parish/private land. Thanks to Councillor McDonald for assisting us with this.
- We continue to water the new trees and shrubs every 3 days, as Duxford gets so little rain. We will try to secure funding for bringing water on site as soon as possible.
- Hortiservices have laid the 2 gravel path sections and they are now hard enough to walk on.
- We have installed a buoyancy aid and floating rope on the dipping deck and a new sign to discourage swimming.
- We have had a lot of compliments from parishioners, this makes all the hard work worthwhile!
- We have decided to reschedule the open day for next Spring as it is too uncertain to plan anything at the moment, with the risk of a second spike in Covid infections remaining a real possibility.
