- The Elms Close entrance pavement has been relaid and has finally met Highways approval, however, we now have to wait a further 12 months before they will return our deposit of £4K+.
- Rob Smit of Hortiservices has almost finished installing the benches, though
 bad weather has stopped work for the time being. Requesting DPC
 agreement to buy one more bench (up to £300) for next to the petanque
 court, as the two coloured benches are junior benches and are too low for less
 than the fittest people to get up from.
- We have an offer of another memorial bench for James Kemp (known as Burma Jim) who died recently aged 95. This will be placed at a location to be decided by the sponsors.
- Sadly the September airshow was cancelled but many parishioners continue to use the field for leisure and exercise and we have had many compliments when we have been working on site.
- The gate to the nectar garden doesn't latch Hortiservises have been asked to correct this, as well as the 2 wobbly bike racks under the shelter.
- The core team is currently working on a maintenance and mowing schedule so that a contract can be let next April. We will also seed different parts of the site with appropriate native seed mixes.
- We are investigating ways to improve access for mobility scooters, including
 possibly installing a solar powered mechanism for the accessible entrance
 opposite the new school gate, to prevent the gate closing on entry.
- The recent rain might have spoiled days out and about, but has been very welcome for the new trees and the volunteers who usually water them!
