The Community Centre in Duxford will provide a much needed community space for various local community groups. Areas for hire will be available between Monday-Saturday 08:00-24:00, Sunday 09:00-23:00 throughout the year, offering conference facilities, as well as private functions areas. Hire costs will be competitive with nearby venues.

Members of the public of all ages have free access to all areas of the recreation grounds and public open spaces owned by Duxford Parish Council and South Cambridgeshire District Council at all times. As such, these areas have unrestricted access to the general public use for cultural, social and recreational activities.
